

# Online Database

Access to our Online Databases is always free, but how you get to them depends on where you are at the time.

## **At Wyandotte:**

If you are at school, then go to our library page:

<http://www.kckpl.lib.ks.us/kckpl/hslib/wyandotte.html>

and select the button “Online Databases.”

## **Not at Wyandotte:**

If you are not at school, you can still access the databases for free with **any** of the following:

1. You live in Wyandotte County:

Go to <http://www.kckpl.lib.ks.us/kckpl/hslib/highsch.html>

You can choose Homework Help for the Gale databases, access the library card catalog, or use the SIRS database at the bottom of the page. SIRS will prompt for user (enter KCK500) and password (enter student).

2. You have a KCK Public Library card:

Go to <http://www.kckpl.lib.ks.us/esource.htm>

and enter your search term in the box. You will be prompted for a userID and PIN. Enter your library card number for the userID, and birthdate (MMDDYYYY) for the PIN.

3. You live in the state of Kansas (but not in Wyandotte County):

Go to

and choose the database you'd like to use.
